PAL Update

A variety of youth recreational sports such as soccer, wrestling, judo* and BMX racing is offered seasonally and year-round* to young people in Santa Clara through the Police Activities League (PAL). The Explorer program is also offered. Here's a summary of what is available this summer:

Judo

Six-week sessions of Judo are taught at Cabrillo Middle School on Thursdays at 6:30 p.m. (ages 5-12) and 7:45 p.m. (13-adult). Learn the basics of this martial art and sport. Contact the PAL Office for information on session dates.

Wrestling

A six-week Summer wrestling session will run from July 9 through August 13 at Wilcox High School. Session times: 5-6:30 p.m. (ages 5-11) or 6:45-8:15 p.m. (ages 12-17). Registration is \$35

Soccer

Soccer sign-ups are now through July 31. First deadline for kids wanting to return to same team as last year is June 30. Boys and girls (ages 4-17). Season starts August 29th and ends approximately the second week in November for Tournament play. Practices are in Santa Clara. Games are in Santa Clara, San Jose or Milpitas on Saturdays. Cost is \$85 per player (includes jersey, socks, picture package, insurance and end of season award). See website for full details.

It includes monthly training sessions, police ride-alongs, involvement in the Record's Bureau and crime prevention, and an annual Academy. Applications are now being accepted.
