Location: 4900 Centennial Boulevard, approximately 40 acres located predominately on the south side of Tasman Drive, as well as a portion of the parcel located on the south side of Tasman Drive at the west side of San Tomas Aquino Creek, and also a portion of parcel APN: 104-03-040, located on the north side of Tasman Drive at the east side of San Tomas Aquino Creek, (APN's: 104-43-030,047,049(part),053(part); 104-03-040; 104-06-012,013,014,017,086).

Request: Review and Comment on Environmental Impact Report analyzing a proposal to Rezone from B (Public/quasi-Public) to PD-B (Planned Development/Public), a General Plan Text Amendment, and an Amendment to the Redevelopment Agency Plan in conjunction with a proposal to allow the construction of a 68,500 seat stadium (expandable to 75,000 seats) for the potential shared use by two NFL teams and approximately 20 non-NFL related significant events per year, and a variance to allow off-site parking
