**Subject:** Bicycle Advisory Committee Comments Regarding Proposed 49er Stadium

At the last Bicycle Advisory Committee (BAC) meeting on March 24, 2010, members commented on the proposed 49er Stadium as it relates to bicycling during major events at this facility. Previously, during the environmental review process for the Stadium Project, the BAC had provided comments and suggestions and their letter was included in the Final Environmental Impact Report.

To summarize, the BAC would like potential conflict between pedestrians and bicyclists addressed specifically at the following four locations:

1. The section of the San Tomas Aquino Creek Trail (Trail) from Agnew Road to the proposed Stadium;
2. The at-grade intersection of the Trail with the Southern Bridge over the creek just south of the proposed Stadium;
3. The at-grade intersection of the Trail with the proposed Pedestrian Bridge located immediately south of Tasman Drive; and,
4. The at-grade intersection of the Trail with the pedestrian bridge adjacent to the Golf & Tennis Club.

The BAC requested that these comments be forwarded to the City Council for consideration in the context of the review of the project should the voters approve the ballot measure in June. This request has also been forwarded to the Planning Department.
