Wrestling



FREE Disaster Preparedness Course

The Santa Clara Fire Department offers a FREE three-hour Disaster Preparedness Course for Santa Clarans. Are you and your loved ones ready for an earthquake or fire? Do you know what to do in a life-threatening emergency? Come and learn emergency preparedness steps to help you plan for a disaster. This acclaimed course is one component of the City's Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) Program. The Santa Clara CERT program is designed to help the citizens of Santa Clara be self-sufficient after a major disaster when the scope of incidents can be overwhelming and the need for a well-trained civilian work force can be invaluable. A major earthquake in the City of Santa Clara will cause damage to homes, roads, and other structures. You can help your family, your neighborhood, your business, and your community to recover by receiving CERT training or becoming part of a CERT. The next FREE Disaster Preparedness Course is August 30th from 6:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. and the last course this year will be on November 1st from 6:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. CERT classes are provided on following weeks for those who wish to continue training.
