



Central Park Master Plan Update

The City of Santa Clara is preparing a Master Plan Update for Central Park. The focus of the Plan has been to create a coherent vision that will integrate and guide Central Park's future improvements by establishing a set of principles, community supported priorities and appropriate professional design criteria. The Plan will help guide future rehabilitation, improvement and/or expansion projects; balancing current uses, historic character, and unique blend of passive park and active recreational spaces for community use. The update will help address the City's Parks and Recreation system-wide goals of: health and fitness; inclusion, sustainability, and age-friendly facilities; while supporting natural habitats and wildlife in our neighborhoods and community.
