INITIAL STUDY DETERMINATION

An Initial Study was completed by the City of Santa Clara in accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), and is available for review in the project file in the Water & Sewer Utilities Engineering office in City Hall at 1500 Warburton Avenue, the Central Library at 2635 Homestead Road in the City of Santa Clara, and online in electronic format at www.santaclaraca.gov/CEQA. The Initial Study analyzes the effects of the installation of a new municipal groundwater production well at the location above. **All projects would incorporate Avoidance and Minimization Measures (AMMs) to reduce community impacts and potential impacts to biological resources, cultural resources, noise, and air quality.** Based upon analysis in the Initial Study, the **projects would not have a significant effect on the environment** with the AMMs and additional mitigation measures identified through the environmental review process incorporated.

Comments may be filed with the City on the Initial Study and Proposed Mitigated Negative Declaration within the review period **beginning Friday December 27, 2019 and ending Tuesday January 28, 2020**, pursuant to Section 15073 of the CEQA Guidelines. Responses received in writing on or before the date of review or verbally at the time of the review of this project will be considered along with the proposed Mitigated Negative Declaration.
