**C**ensus Day is April 1, 2020, but households will start receiving mail about filling out their census as early as March! Here is what you can expect to receive and when:

- March 12-20: Invitations to respond to the 2020 Census online.
- March 16-24: A reminder postcard.
- March 26-April 3: Another reminder postcard.
- April 1: Census Day!
- April 8-16: A reminder letter and paper questionnaire.
- April 20-27: A final reminder postcard before a Census Bureau representative follows up in person.
