► Stay Informed about Coronavirus (COVID-19) SantaClaraCA.gov/CoronavirusUpdates

Effective March 17, 2020, the City of Santa Clara is providing only essential public services, such as fire and police services, electric, water and sewer services, and trash and recycling pickup, to comply with the County of Santa Clara's order. City facilities remain closed including libraries, community centers, and the Santa Clara Senior Center until further notice. Emergency services continue 24/7.

To slow down the spread of COVID-19, events previously scheduled for April such as Earth Day/Arbor Day, Egg-Stravaganza and the Citywide Garage Sale are now canceled.
