ATTENTION: Please read carefully before conducting your housing search

The Affordable Housing Resource Guide is a listing of affordable housing facilities and housing service programs. This is not an all-inclusive guide; there may be other resources available. While every effort is made to keep this listing up to date, some information may not be current. As many of the properties listed in this resource guide have waitlists, please contact them directly to inquire if they are accepting applications for their waitlist.

Tips for calling properties that offer existing affordable housing:

- If no one answers the phone, try calling again at different times and days. Do not assume that property managers will return your call.
- If you cannot reach the property manager by phone, visit the leasing office during business hours. Most leasing office business hours may be found online.
- Below are some questions to ask the property manager to collect the information you need in your search:
 - Do you have a vacancy for a unit?
 - What is the monthly rent?
 - Do you have max/min income requirements?
 - Do you have other requirements?
 - What type of supplemental income do you accept?
 - Do you maintain a waitlist?
 - How long is your waitlist and how do I get on the waitlist?
 - If the waitlist is closed when is it going to be open?
 - How do I apply?
 - Is there an application fee?

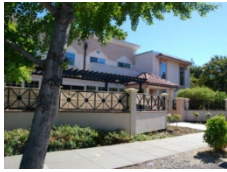
