## **Free Legal Services Are Still Available for Santa Clara County Residents Age 60 or Older During COVID-19 Pandemic**

Due to Social Distancing and the closure of senior centers in Santa Clara County, SALA is not able to offer our appointments at these sites. Our Central Office is also closed to the public. However, SALA is an essential service, so we continue to provide free legal services to Santa Clara County seniors 60 or older during the COVID-19 pandemic. Our attorneys are working remotely and are assisting current clients and new clients primarily by telephone.

### **SALA may be able to help with legal matters or problems in the following areas:**

- **Public Benefits/Entitlement Programs:** Social Security, Medicare (including HMO's and Advantage Plans), SSI, Medi-Cal, In-Home Supportive Services
- **Prevention of Elder Abuse or Domestic Violence:** Restraining Orders (to remove physically abusive persons from your home and/or to order them stay away from you), Revocation of Powers of Attorney (for financial or fiduciary abuse)
- **Housing:** Landlord-Tenant, Subsidized/Senior Housing, Mobile Home Residency, Fair Housing (including requests for accommodations by landlords for a disability)
- **Nursing Homes, Residential Care, and Alternatives to Institutionalization**
- **Planning for Your Future During COVID 19:** Advance Health Care Directives, Health Care Powers of Attorney, Uniform Statutory Form Powers of Attorney (for financial management), Simple Wills for persons with modest assets including instructions on how to do Holographic (handwritten) Wills
